2 STATEMENT OF FACT

Sections 1 to 5 ensure that all municipal school representatives on the governing bodies of the various types of school units in the State are subject to exactly the same rule regarding the forfeiture of office if absent from 3 consecutive regularly scheduled meetings of those bodies.
