## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT Concerning Intermediate Care Facilities for the Mentally Retarded.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3186, as repealed and replaced 7 by PL 1987, c. 402, Pt. A, §140, is amended by adding 8 at the end a new paragraph to read:

Rules. The department, in consultation 6 Sec. 2. with the Bureau of Mental Retardation and providers of 7 8 community-based services for persons with mental 9 retardation, shall develop rules regarding in-service education, as required in the competency-based career ladder for employees of community-based intermediate 10 11 12 care facilities, for the employees of residential 13 facilities for the mentally retarded. These rules shall cover type, content and length of in-service 14 15 education programs which are required for advancement 16 within the proposed career ladder. These rules shall 17 be promulgated no later than April 1, 1989.

18 Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are 19 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the 20 purposes of this Act.
