the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days
after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is the intent of the Legislature to
immediately establish a teaching nursing home project
on a demonstration basis with the Maine Veterans'
Home, Inc.; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the
Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety;
now, therefore,
