1 AN ACT to Correct the Expiration Date for the
2 Term of Office for a Washington County
3 Commissioner.
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 30-A MRSA §66, sub-§15, ¶C, as enacted by PL
8 1988, c. 737, §2, is amended to read:

9 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the

1 municipalities and unorganized territories of
2 Deblois, Cherryfield, Steuben, Milbridge,
3 Harrington, Addison, Jonesport, Beals, Beddington,
4 Columbia, Columbia Falls, Centerville, Jonesboro,
5 Roque Bluffs, Whitneyville, Marshfield and Machias
6 and unorganized territories of Deveraux T29 MD,
7 T24 MD, T18 MD and T19 MD. The term of office of
8 the commissioner from this district shall expire
9 in ~~1988~~ 1990 and every 4 years thereafter.

10 STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This bill corrects the year in which the 4-year
12 term for a Washington County Commissioner from
13 District 3 should expire.
