COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 1016, L.D. 2667,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Borrowing Capacity of  
the Stonington Water Company."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting  
clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the  
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days  
after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Stonington Water District needs to  
make improvements to its system in order meet the  
requirements of the Department of Human Services; and

Whereas, it is necessary to increase the debt  
limit of the district in order to borrow funds to make  
the improvements; and

Whereas, it is strongly desired to begin  
improvements as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the  
Constitution of Maine and require the following  
legislation as immediately necessary for the  
preservation of the public peace, health and safety;  
now, therefore,'

Further amend the bill by adding at the end before  
the statement of fact the following:

1 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency  
2 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when  
3 approved.'

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 This bill adds an emergency preamble and an  
6 emergency clause in order to permit the Stonington  
7 Water District to begin improvements to its water  
8 system this autumn.
