7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 1016, L.D. 2667, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Borrowing Capacity of 9 the Stonington Water Company."

10 Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting 11 clause the following:

12 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the 13 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days 14 after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

15 Whereas, the Stonington Water District needs to 16 make improvements to its system in order meet the 17 requirements of the Department of Human Services; and

18 Whereas, it is necessary to increase the debt 19 limit of the district in order to borrow funds to make 20 the improvements; and

21 Whereas, it is strongly desired to begin 22 improvements as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

29 Further amend the bill by adding at the end before 30 the statement of fact the following:

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 1016, L.D. 2667

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 1 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.' 2 3 4

STATEMENT OF FACT

5 This bill adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause in order to permit the Stonington Water District to begin improvements to its water 6 7 8 system this autumn.
