1 RESOLVE, Concerning the Special Commission on  
2 Boating.  
3

4 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves  
5 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90  
6 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;  
7 and

8 Whereas, the changes proposed in this legislation  
9 are immediately necessary in order that the Special

1 Commission on Boating is able to continue its mission  
2 without interruption and complete its study by the  
3 imposed deadline; and

4 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
5 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the  
6 Constitution of Maine and require the following  
7 legislation as immediately necessary for the  
8 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;  
9 now, therefore, be it

10 Resolve 1987, c. 111, amended. Resolved: That  
11 Resolve 1987, c. 111, the 7th resolve clause, be  
12 amended by repealing and replacing all of the  
13 appropriation:

14 Appropriation. Resolved: That the following  
15 funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry  
16 out the purposes of this resolve.

1 FISCAL NOTE

2 The cost of providing per diem for the remaining  
3 meetings to the Legislators serving on the special  
4 commission can be absorbed within the existing  
5 appropriation to the Special Commission on Boating.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 This resolve amends the resolve creating the  
8 Special Commission on Boating to provide for one  
9 additional meeting and the payment of per diem to the  
10 Legislators for the remaining 2 meetings.
