RESOLVE, Concerning the Special Commission on Boating.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the changes proposed in this legislation are immediately necessary in order that the Special

4 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 5 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the 6 Constitution of Maine and require the following 7 legislation as immediately necessary for the 8 preservation of the public peace, health and safety; 9 now, therefore, be it
