2	STATEMENT OF FACT
3 4	This amendment makes the following changes in the bill.
5 6 7	It amends the bill in section 1 to clarify the qualifications for the Nuclear Safety Inspector position.
8 9 .0 .1 .2 .3 .4	It also deletes the requirement that the knowledge of the applicant be restricted to "commercial" nuclear power production. The amendment deletes a fee amount which was a fee for the last fiscal year; makes a technical correction in the language which was proposed to include off-site monitoring costs in the registration fee; and adds an allocation and fiscal note.
