1                   AN ACT to Amend the Limitation of  
2                   Indebtedness for the Starks Water  
3                   District.

5           Emergency preamble.       Whereas, Acts of the  
6   Legislature do not become effective until 90 days  
7   after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

8           Whereas, the water supply for domestic purposes in  
9   the Town of Starks is not in compliance with state

1 rules for drinking water; and

2 Whereas, this legislation is immediately necessary  
3 so that the town may borrow the funds to remedy the  
4 situation; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
6 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the  
7 Constitution of Maine and require the following  
8 legislation as immediately necessary for the  
9 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;  
10 now, therefore,

11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
12 follows:

13 P&SL 1961, c. 40, §9, 2nd sentence is amended to  
14 read:

15 For the purpose of obtaining or providing money to pay  
16 or to meet any necessary expenses and liabilities  
17 under the provisions of this act, including expenses  
18 in the creation of this district, in securing sources  
19 of supply, taking water and land, paying damages,  
20 laying pipes, constructing, maintaining and operating  
21 a water plant, and making extensions, additions and  
22 improvements to the same, the said district, through  
23 its trustees, may from time to time issue bonds of the  
24 district to an amount not exceeding \$15,000  
25 \$100,000, maturing and payable at such time or times,  
26 in uniform or varying installments, with or without  
27 such call provisions, and with or without such a  
28 premium or premiums, as said trustees shall determine.

29 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency  
30 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when  
31 approved.
