COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 1026, L.D. 2682,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Expedite the Allocation of Solid
9 Waste Management Assistance."

10

Amend the Bill in the emergency preamble by
11 striking out all of the 5th paragraph.

12

Further amend the Bill in the emergency preamble
13 by striking out all of the next to the last paragraph
14 and inserting in its place the following:

15

'Whereas, the siting and development of stump and
16 demolition debris disposal facilities and tires and
17 white goods disposal facilities require extensive
18 planning and technical expertise not readily available
19 to many municipalities; and'

20

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking
21 out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the
22 following:

23

'4. Technical assistance. The department is
24 authorized to establish guidelines for effective waste
25 management, to provide technical assistance to persons
26 planning, constructing or operating waste facilities,
27 and to conduct applied research activities in the
28 field of waste management, including methods of
29 recycling hazardous or solid waste, sludge or
30 septage. The department shall develop a pilot program

1 to provide grants for the identification, design and
2 development of tire and white goods disposal
3 facilities, including pickup of these items, and stump
4 and demolition debris disposal facilities by
5 municipalities, county governments and regional
6 planning agencies.'

7 Further amend the Bill in section 2 in the 6th
8 line (page 3, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the
9 following: "January 1," and inserting in its place
10 the following: 'January 15,'

11 Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking
12 out all of the last sentence (page 3, lines 17 to 19
13 in L.D.).

14 Further amend the Bill by striking out all of
15 section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

16 'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds
17 are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out
18 the purposes of this Act.
