STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment establishes a pilot program of grants to municipalities in the Department of Environmental Protection's Bureau of Solid Waste. Grants will be used to assist municipalities in identifying, designing and developing stump and demolition debris landfills and tire and white goods disposal facilities.

9 The amendment also establishes a deadline for the 10 adoption of solid waste disposal rules currently under 11 revision.
