12 13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16	Whereas, harness racing is one of Maine's most important recreational activities; and
17 18 19	Whereas, harness racing is vital for the continued prosperity of those agricultural societies which conduct pari-mutuel wagering; and
20 21 22	Whereas, the harness racing industry is in jeopardy because of increased costs of maintenance and labor and is in immediate need of relief; and
23 24 25	Whereas, this Act should become effective immediately to provide additional funds for the State Harness Racing Commission to operate efficiently; and
26 27	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the
