Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
Whereas, it is imperative that the cleanup of redeemable shellfish areas on the coast be accelerated

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- immediately by the means provided in this legislation; 1 2 and
- Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 4 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the 5 following Constitution of Maine and require the 6 legislation immediately necessary for the i as 7 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;

- Authorization of bonds to provide Treasurer of 14 sewerage facilities construction. This Act shall be submitted to the legal voters of the State at the next general election in the month of November following passage of this Act. The city aldermen, town selectmen and plantation assessors of this State shall notify the inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide election, to vote on the acceptance or rejection of this Act by voting on the following question:

The Governor shall review the returns and, if it appears that a majority of the legal voters are in favor of the Act, the Governor shall proclaim that fact without delay and the Act shall become effective 30 days after the date of the proclamation.
