SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1996, L.D. 2698,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Maine Managed Care
Insurance Plan Demonstration for Uninsured
Individuals."

Amend the bill by inserting after the title the
following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days
after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this legislation is immediately necessary
to ensure that low-income workers employed by small
businesses may obtain adequate health insurance; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the
Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety;
now, therefore,'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when
approved.'


