COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 1042, L.D. 2703,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Extend Temporarily the Time Period  
During Which the Department of Marine Resources May  
Conduct On-site Evaluations of Coastal Aquaculture  
Installations."

Amend the bill by striking out all of subsection  
5-B and inserting in its place the following:

'5-B. Extension of site review; Toothacher Bay;  
repeal. Notwithstanding the time period specified in  
subsection 5-A, the department shall conduct site  
reviews on applications for finfish aquaculture  
projects in Toothacher Bay on Swan's Island from  
December 1, 1988 to May 1, 1989 if ice conditions  
permit. This subsection is repealed on May 1, 1989.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the  
emergency clause and inserting in its place the  
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency  
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when  
approved.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           This amendment restricts the extension of time for  
3 Department of Marine Resources site review of  
4 aquaculture leases to finfish applications in  
5 Toothacher Bay on Swan's Island. It also clarifies  
6 that the department is required to make the site  
7 review and enlarges the period for review to include  
8 the month of December, 1988.
