STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Extend Temporarily the Time Period During Which the Department of Marine Resources May Conduct On-site Evaluations of Coastal Aquaculture Installations.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, currently required site evaluations on the part of the Department of Marine Resources biologists may only be conducted between May 1st and September 30th annually; and

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26 27 Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as an emergency measure and those dates are suspended, individuals involved in the aquaculture industry will be precluded from effectively pursuing production since stocking and seeding must occur early in the limited optimal growing season in Maine; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

17 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 18 follows:

12 MRSA §6072, sub-§5-B is enacted to read:

5-B. Extension of site review; repeal.
Notwithstanding the site reviews authorized in subsection 5-A, the department may conduct site reviews from January 1, 1989 until May 1, 1989. This subsection is repealed on May 1, 1989.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on January 1, 1989.
