**AN ACT to Extend the Reporting Deadline of the  
Commission to Implement the  
Computerization of Criminal History Record  
Information.**

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Commission to Implement the

1 Computerization of Criminal History Record Information  
2 requires additional time to oversee the development  
3 and implementation of an effective computerized  
4 system; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
6 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the  
7 Constitution of Maine and require the following  
8 legislation as immediately necessary for the  
9 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;  
10 now, therefore,

11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
12 follows:

13 Sec. 1. P&SL 1987, c. 84, §1, last sentence is  
14 amended to read:

15 The commission shall present its final report and  
16 recommendations, together with any recommended  
17 legislation, to the First Regular Session of the 114th  
18 Legislature by ~~January 15~~ June 1, 1989.

19 Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are  
20 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the  
21 purposes of this Act.

4 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency  
5 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when  
6 approved.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This bill extends the final reporting date of the  
9 Commission to Implement the Computerization of  
10 Criminal History Record Information and provides funds  
11 so that the commission may continue its work.

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
