1           **AN ACT to Extend the Reporting Deadline of the**  
2           **Commission to Study the Impact of Game and**  
3           **Nongame Species on Maine's Economy.**

5           **Emergency preamble.**       Whereas, Acts of the  
6           Legislature do not become effective until 90 days  
7           after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

8           Whereas, unless this legislation takes effect  
9           immediately, the commission will be unable to submit

1 its interim report in a timely manner; and

2 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
3 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the  
4 Constitution of Maine and require the following  
5 legislation as immediately necessary for the  
6 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;  
7 now, therefore,

8 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
9 follows:

10 PL 1987, c. 554, §3, first paragraph is amended  
11 to read:

12 The departments shall utilize the General Fund  
13 support as matching funds for any available federal  
14 funds on a 25% state, 75% federal cost share basis.  
15 The contractor shall report at least monthly to the  
16 commission and shall be required to submit an interim  
17 report to the commission by December ~~17~~ 23, 1988,  
18 and a final report no later than December 1, 1990.

19 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency  
20 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when  
21 approved.

22 STATEMENT OF FACT

23 The purpose of this bill is to extend the interim  
24 reporting deadline of the Commission to Study the  
25 Impact of Game and Nongame Species on Maine's Economy  
26 from December 1, 1988 to December 23, 1988.
