1 **AN ACT to Extend the Reporting Deadline of the**
2 **Special Commission to Study School Funding and**
3 **State Tax Law.**

5 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the
6 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days
7 after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

8 Whereas, unless this legislation takes effect
9 immediately, the commission will be unable to submit

1 its final report in a timely manner; and

2 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
3 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the
4 Constitution of Maine and require the following
5 legislation as immediately necessary for the
6 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;
7 now, therefore;

8 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
9 follows:

10 Sec. 1. PL 1987, c. 848, §11, sub-§2, ¶J is
11 amended to read:

12 J. Complete the study by December 6, 1988,
13 January 30, 1989 and report to the Governor and
14 the First Regular Session of the 114th Legislature.

15 Sec. 2. Transition. Members who were appointed
16 to the special commission pursuant to Public Law 1987,
17 chapter 848, section 11, subsection 1, shall continue
18 to serve on the special commission until January 30,
19 1989.

20 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
21 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when
22 approved.

23 STATEMENT OF FACT

24 The purpose of this bill is to extend the final
25 deadline of the Special Commission to Study School
26 Funding and State Tax Law from December 6, 1988 to
27 January 30, 1989.
