HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 634, "JOINT RESOLUTION
MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO RESTORE FULL
CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS TO MAINE VETERANS WHO BORE ARMS IN DEFENSE
OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA"

Amend the joint resolution by striking out all of the title
and inserting in its place the following:

'JOINT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED
STATES TO ENSURE FULL CITIZENS' RIGHTS OF MAINE VETERANS WHO BORE
ARMS IN DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND TO VOLUNTEERS
AND INDUCTEES OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES'

Further amend the joint resolution by striking out all of
the 2nd, 3rd and 4th "WHEREAS" paragraphs.

Further amend the joint resolution by striking out all of
the 8th "WHEREAS" paragraph and inserting in its place the
following:

'WHEREAS, Maine citizens entering the Armed Forces of the
United States are not informed at time of enlistment of any
nonmilitary citizens' rights they may be forfeiting by taking an
oath to uphold, protect and defend the Constitution of the United
States of America; and'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the title of the joint resolution,
strikes out 3 paragraphs in the preamble and clarifies that Maine
citizens entering the Armed Forces of the United States are not
