HOUSE AMENDMENT " **B** " to H.P. 634, "JOINT RESOLUTION
MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO RESTORE FULL
CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS TO MAINE VETERANS WHO BORE ARMS IN DEFENSE
OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA"

Amend the joint resolution by striking out all of the title
and inserting in its place the following:

'JOINT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED
STATES TO ENSURE FULL CITIZENS' RIGHTS OF MAINE VETERANS WHO BORE
ARMS IN DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA'

Further amend the joint resolution by striking out all of
the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 8th "WHEREAS" paragraphs.

Further amend the joint resolution by striking out all of
the 2nd "Resolved:" paragraph.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the title of the joint resolution,
strikes out 4 paragraphs in the preamble and removes the request
that the Congress of the United States shall require the
Secretary of Defense be directed to inform all citizens
volunteering or otherwise inducted into the Armed Forces of the
United States of their constitutional rights and of any rights
their service shall cause the volunteer or inductee to forfeit,
and that the notification be accomplished in writing prior to
entering the military service.
