	WHEREAS, the people of Maine have watched with admiration
36	during the past 6 months as the peoples of Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, the German Democratic Republic, Hungary, Poland,

WHEREAS, such expressions of freedom have also erupted, only to be put down with brute force, in Albania and the People's Republic of China; and

2 WHEREAS, the people of Maine are preparing to attend our local town meetings, a cherished Maine tradition and the purest expression of democratic government; and WHEREAS, individual expressions of conscience and humanity have touched responsive chords in millions of fellow citizens of 8 communist countries who have been inspired to add their voices to the collective demand for freedom of assembly, freedom of the 10 press, freedom of religion, representative self-government and market-based economies; and 12 WHEREAS, on our own behalf, and on behalf of the people of the State of Maine, we wish to express our support for this 14 evolving process, which is bringing new vitality, 16 adoption of democratic values, decentralized governance pluralistic self-representation to these countries; and 18 WHEREAS, we express our admiration for the efforts of these 20 people and wish to encourage them in these efforts and to continue to move forward toward a world of reduced tension in 22 which all governments recognize individual liberties and promote human dignity; now, therefore, be it 24 RESOLVED: That We, your Memorialists, urge the President and 26 Congress of the United States to support the efforts of the people of these nations to forge governments of their own 28 choosing, to help them with sufficient moral and financial aid to ensure the success of those who have already achieved their 30 freedom and to bolster the hopes and aspirations of those whose thirst for freedom has yet to be fulfilled; and be it further 32 That suitable copies of this Memorial, duly authenticated by the Secretary of State, be transmitted to the 34 Honorable George H. W. Bush, President of the United States, to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 36 Representatives of the Congress of the United States and to each Member of the Maine Congressional Delegation.' 38 40 STATEMENT OF FACT 42 This amendment strikes the entire memorial and replaces it with a memorial to Congress and the President of the United 44 States urging aid and support for the people of Eastern Europe and other areas under the control of single party communist 46 states who are changing their systems of government. 48
