1	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted

5	Whereas, it is necessary that this legislation be enacted as an emergency measure so that the Secretary of State may meet
7	financial obligations resulting from the June primary and the November general elections; and

11	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
