AN ACT to Continue the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study the Regulation of Health Care Expenditures.

(EMERGENCY)



1	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
3	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
5	Whereas, it is necessary to continue the life of the Commission to Study the Regulation of Health Care Expenditures
7	beyond its reporting deadline of January 15, 1989; and
9	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
11	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
