STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Clarify Eligiblity for the STAR Program.

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, railroad and railway workers are eligible for the STAR program and are in need of its services, but Department of Labor rules make them ineligible; and

Whereas, there is an immediate need to overturn rules of the department that are contrary to legislative intent; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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26 MRSA §2015-A, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 775, §3, 21 is amended to read:

23 2. Program goals. The purpose of this section is to establish an employment training program to provide unemployed or displaced workers with skills training and support which lead to 25 jobs in stable and expanding industries, as well as support services so that individuals are able to take advantage of 27 educational and training opportunities. A further purpose of the STAR program is to provide employers with trained workers by 29 ensuring that the training provided is consistent with the needs Unemployed or displaced railroad and railway 31 of employers. workers who are residents of the State shall be eligible to 33 participate in the program if they otherwise meet program eligibility requirements.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 37 preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill clarifies that unemployed and displaced railroad and railway workers may participate in the STAR program. The
Department of Labor has enacted rules that bar their participation, which is contrary to legislative intent and the
purpose of this program.

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
