Item Vetoes"

Amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the
following:

FISCAL NOTE

If this bill is enacted, there would be a cost to the
General Fund to cover the referendum expense incurred by the
Secretary of State. The estimated cost will be as follows:

1 to 6 Referenda	\$88,000
Each additional referendum	\$5,300'
