19	Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the emergency preamble and before the emergency clause and inserting
21	in its place the following:
23	'Aroostook County sesquicentennial plates authorized. Resolved: That a reflectorized, commemorative, simulated motor vehicle
25	registration plate in celebration of the sesquicentennial of Aroostook County, designed, distributed and sold by the
27	Aroostook County Sesquicentennial Committee, may be displayed to replace the front registration plate on any motor vehicle
29	registered in this State, except truck tractors, from January 1, 1989 to December 31, 1989. The commemorative sesquicentennial
31	plate may be displayed on motor vehicles, except truck tractors, registered outside this State, but operated within this State,
33	in the same manner as provided for vehicles registered in this State. No such commemorative plates may be sold, distributed or
35	displayed which are not approved by the Aroostook County Sesquicentennial Committee.

41	If enacted, this amendment would remove the responsibility
43	of manufacturing and distributing the commemorative plates from the Division of Motor Vehicles. The amended resolve would
45	therefore not have any fiscal impact on the State.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment retains the concept of the resolve, authorizing the display of an Aroostook County sesquicentennial plate replacing the front registration plate of any motor vehicle, except truck tractors, during calendar year 1989. The amendment deletes all reference to the Division of Motor Vehicles and, therefore, does not require any fees to the State nor any allocation of state funds. The commemorative plates would be designed, distributed and sold by the Aroostook County Sesquicentennial Committee.
