COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 16, L.D. 8, Bill, "An Act to Enhance the Management of the Fish and Game Resources of the State of Maine"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 7 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 7. Transition provision. The Governor shall submit legislation by January 1, 1990, necessary to carry out the intent of this Act with regard to appropriating funds from the General Fund and deallocating funds from the Special Revenue account. Encumbered balances as of June 30, 1990, in the Other Special Revenue accounts affected by this Act shall be transferred to appropriate General Fund accounts in fiscal year 1990-91.

Sec. 8. Effective date. Sections 1, 6 and 7 shall take effect January 1, 1990. Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 shall take effect July 1, 1990.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will increase the General Fund revenues as follows:

	<b>1990-91</b>
Increase in General Fund revenues	\$14,334,362

Legislation to appropriate funds to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will be presented to the Second Regular Session of the 114th Legislature.'
