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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 40, L.D. 9, "Resolve, to
Extend the Reporting Deadline for the Commission on Maine's
Future"

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Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the
emergency preamble and before the emergency clause and inserting
in its place the following:

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Resolve 1987, c. 60, amended. Resolved: That Resolve 1987, c.
60, the 2nd resolve clause, 2nd paragraph, 2nd sentence, is
amended to read:

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The commission members shall serve terms to expire on ~~July 1,~~
1989 May 1, 1990, to enable the commission to advise the
Legislature with respect to the proposals and to follow the
implementation of the proposals of the commission.

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; and be it further

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Resolve 1987, c. 60, amended. Resolved: That Resolve 1987, c.
60, the 3rd resolve clause, sub-§6, is amended to read:

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6. A formal final report on commission activities to be
submitted to the Governor and to the joint standing committee of
the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local
government not later than ~~January 1, 1989~~ June 15, 1989. ~~The
final report shall contain any necessary implementing
legislation.~~ Any necessary legislation implementing
recommendations of the final report on commission activities
shall be submitted to the Governor and to the joint standing
committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and
local government not later than January 15, 1990.

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Resolve 1987, c. 60, amended. Resolved: That Resolve 1987, c.
60, the last resolve clause, is amended by adding at the end a
new sentence to read:

R. of S.

1 Funds appropriated by the Legislature to the commission for
3 fiscal year 1987-1988 or fiscal year 1988-89 shall not lapse, but
5 shall be carried forward to fiscal year 1989-90 to enable the
7 commission to complete its obligations.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This amendment extends the final reporting deadline for the
13 Commission on Maine's Future to June 15, 1989, and to extend the
15 deadline for submission of legislation to January 15, 1990. It
17 also extends the life of the commission to May 1, 1990, to enable
19 it to advise the Legislature with respect to its recommendations
and implementing legislation.

17 This amendment provides that the funds already appropriated
19 to the commission shall not lapse at the end of fiscal year
1989. No additional funds are needed for this extension.
