STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment extends the final reporting deadline for the Commission on Maine's Future to June 15, 1989, and to extend the deadline for submission of legislation to January 15, 1990. It also extends the life of the commission to May 1, 1990, to enable it to advise the Legislature with respect to its recommendations and implementing legislation.

17 This amendment provides that the funds already appropriated to the commission shall not lapse at the end of fiscal year
19 1989. No additional funds are needed for this extension.
