RESOLVE, to Extend the Reporting Deadline for the Commission on Maine's Future.

(EMERGENCY)



1	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
3	Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
5	Whereas, it is necessary that this legislation be enacted as an emergency measure so that the Commission on Maine's Future
7	may make its final report in a comprehensive and timely manner; and
9	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
11	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
13	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
15	safety; now, therefore, be it
17	Resolve 1987, c. 60, amended. Resolved: That Resolve 1987, c. 60, the 3rd resolve clause, sub- $\S 6$, is amended to read:
19	6. A formal final report on commission activities to be submitted to the Governor and to the joint standing committee of
21	the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government not later than January-1,1989 April 15, 1989. The
23	final report shall contain any necessary implementing legislation.
25	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
