No claim may be paid unless the claim is filed with the 9 Bureau of Taxation on or after August-<u>lst</u> June lst and on or before the following October 15th. 11

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill extends the period for filing a claim with the Bureau of Taxation. The period for filing will begin on June 1st rather than August 1st and continue to October 15th.
