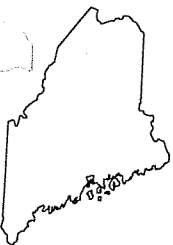

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**AN ACT to Facilitate the Payment of Taxes by Persons Eligible under  
the Household Tax and Rent Refund Act.**

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1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **36 MRSA §6204**, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 516, §§3 and 6, is  
5 amended to read:

7 **§6204. Filing date**

9 No claim may be paid unless the claim is filed with the  
11 Bureau of Taxation on or after ~~August--1st~~ June 1st and on or  
13 before the following October 15th.

15 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

17 This bill extends the period for filing a claim with the  
Bureau of Taxation. The period for filing will begin on June 1st  
rather than August 1st and continue to October 15th.
