HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 33,
L.D. 33, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Bureau of Veterans'
Services to Provide Assistance to Vietnam Veterans"

Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of
subsection 8 (page 2, lines 3 to 8 in amendment) and inserting in
its place the following:

'8. Veterans' Commission on Expenses Only 37-B MRSA
Services Vietnam and §521'
Atomic Veterans

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part
designated "§522." in subsection 1, in paragraph D in the first
line (page 3, line 47 in the amendment) by striking out the
underlined word "Was" and inserting in its place the underlined
word 'Is'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 by striking out all
of that part designated "§523." and inserting in its place the
following:

'§523. Membership

The commission shall consist of 8 members, 6 of whom shall
be appointed by the Governor, including 3 Vietnam veterans, one
atomic veteran, one veteran appointed from a list of 3 veterans
selected by the Maine Veterans' Coordinating Committee and one
person knowledgeable in conducting publicity campaigns; the
Director of the Bureau of Veterans' Services or a designee; and
the Director of Disease Control or a designee.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment corrects a technical error in section 1. It changes the tense of a verb in section 3, in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 37-B, section 522. Finally, it removes the legislative members and the member from Togas Hospital and adds an additional Vietnam veteran to allow the committee to implement the policies under its responsibilities.
