17	STATEMENT OF FACT
19	The purpose of this amendment is to permit out-of-state
21	vehicles that cannot be registered for at least 90,000 pounds in their home jurisdiction to acquire a permit in this State for a
23	period of 3 months or more at a monthly prorated fee. The original committee amendment requires that this permit be
25	obtained for a full year. A minimum 3-month period allows the 90,000-pound permit to run concurrently with any 100,000-pound
27	permit.
