| 43 | This amendment replaces the original bill which established a phased-in reduction in class size in grades kindergarten to 4 over the next 5 years. That bill was recommended by the Special |
| 45 | Commission to Study Early Childhood Development and Education. This amendment directs the Department of Educational and Cultural |
| 47 | Services to conduct a study on the impact of class size reductions and to estimate the cost of implementing the |
| 49 | reductions and to estimate the cost of implementing the reductions. |
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
