COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 60, L.D. 43, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to the Maine Correctional Advisory Commission"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of  
subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Correc- tions	Maine Correc- tional Policy Advisory Commission	\$25/Day Expenses and \$25/day for non- legislative members. Expenses and legislative per diem for legislative members.	34-A MRSA §1204-A'
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Further amend the bill in section 3, in subsection 1,  
paragraph C, in the first line (page 1, line 42 in L.D.) by  
striking out the following: "One member" and inserting in its  
place the following: 'Two members'

Further amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated  
"§1204-A.", in subsection 1, in paragraph J, in the first line  
(page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Ten"  
and inserting in its place the following: 'Nine'

Further amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated  
"§1204-A.", in subsection 1, in paragraph J, by striking out  
subparagraph (3) (page 2, lines 18 and 19 in L.D.) and inserting  
in its place the following:

'(3) One nongovernmental provider of adult correctional  
services and one nongovernmental provider of juvenile  
correctional services;'

Further amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated

1 "§1204-A.", in subsection 5, in the last line (page 3, line 20 in  
L.D.) by inserting after the following: "commission." the  
3 following:

5 'The commission may appoint the Juvenile Justice Advisory Group  
to act as its subcommittee in matters regarding juvenile  
7 corrections policy.'

9 Further amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated  
11 "§1204-A.", in subsection 6, by striking out all of paragraph A  
and inserting in its place the following:

13 'A. Regularly advise the Governor, commissioner, the  
Legislature and the Judicial Department on issues concerning  
15 adult and juvenile corrections policy, including monitoring  
implementation of the recommendations of the Juvenile  
17 Corrections Planning Commission; and'

19 Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 4 and  
inserting in its place the following:

21 'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated  
23 from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

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**FISCAL NOTE**

The Judicial Department has indicated that it can absorb the costs of providing judicial advisors to the commission within its resources.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment has 5 purposes:

1. To provide for legislative per diem for commission members who are legislators;
2. To increase the representation of juvenile corrections service providers;
3. To include the Juvenile Justice Advisory Group as a participant in the commission's work;
4. To add monitoring of juvenile corrections policy to the commission's duties; and
5. To amend the appropriations section to reflect the fiscal impact of the bill, and to add a fiscal note.
