This bill expands the existing early childhood education plans grants program to encourage the development	1-92

programs for young children. Specifically, the bill expands application of the grants program to cover 4 to 9 year old 1 children; identifies the transition from preschool to public 3 school and parental education needs as additional areas for grant programs; adds a model program grants component to the existing 5 program; directs the Department of Educational and Cultural 7 Services to encourage broad participation in the grant program and provide technical support to local school units; eliminates the local match requirement of the current program; establishes a 9 \$50,000 grant maximum; and appropriates additional funds to carry 11 out the purposes of this bill.
