1	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted

5	Whereas, a restructuring of license fees for the sale of							
7	beer and wine to be consumed off the premises where sold was undertaken in the revision of liquor laws during the First Regular Session of the 113th Legislature; and

11	Whereas, the restructuring was designed to produce no net loss of revenue to the State because, as some license fees were lowered, others were raised; and
