**An Act to Provide Rest Breaks for Certain Persons Exempted from the
Minimum Wage Law.**



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **26 MRSA §601, sub-§2 is enacted to read:**

5 2. Exception. Notwithstanding section 663, taxicab drivers
7 shall receive rest breaks during the workday in accordance with
9 this section.

11 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

13 This bill ensures that all taxicab drivers shall receive
15 rest time during the workday.
