An Act to Provide Rest Breaks for Certain Persons Exempted from the Minimum Wage Law.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

26 MRSA §601, sub-§2 is enacted to read:

 5 <u>2. Exception.</u> Notwithstanding section 663, taxicab drivers shall receive rest breaks during the workday in accordance with
