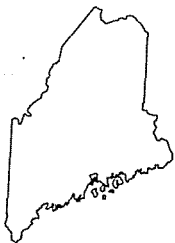

An Act to Prohibit the Use of Personal Watercraft.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **12 MRSA §7801, sub-§30** is enacted to read:

5 30. Operating a personal watercraft. A person is guilty of
7 operating a personal watercraft if that person operates or
9 attempts to operate a personal watercraft on any waters in the
11 State.

13 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

15 This bill contains the minority recommendation of the Maine
17 Special Commission on Boating, created by Resolves 1987, chapter
19 111.

This bill makes it a Class E crime for any person to operate
or attempt to operate a personal watercraft, such as a jet ski,
in the State.
