An Act to Make Additional Allocations for Administrative Expenses of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages, Department of Finance, for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1989.

(EMERGENCY)



1 3	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
5	Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and
7	Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the
9	operation of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages will become due and payable before the next fiscal year; and
11	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
13	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
15	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
17	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21	Sec. 1. Additional allocation of fund. In order to provide for the necessary expenses of operation and administration of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages, the following amount is allocated
23	from the revenues derived from operation of the State Alcoholic Beverage Fund.
