STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Amend the Sales Tax Exemption for Out-of-State Residents Purchasing Trailers in Maine.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

36 MRSA §1760, sub-§23-A, as amended by PL 1985, c. 691, §12, is further amended to read:

23-A. Truck bodies and trailers. Truck bodies, semi-trailers semitrailers, and trailers, manufactured-in-Mainer except camper bodies and trailers, purchased by a nonresident who intends to remove them immediately from the State upon delivery by the seller. If the truck body, semi-trailer semitrailer or trailer is returned to Maine for an otherwise taxable use in Maine within 12 months of the date of purchase, the purchaser shall be liable for use tax, based on the original purchase price.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the sales tax exemption for trailers purchased by out-of-state residents by removing the requirement that the trailers be manufactured in Maine.
