**An Act to Make Additional Allocations from the Maine Nuclear
Emergency Planning Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1989.**

(EMERGENCY)



1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
3 as emergencies; and

5 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after
6 the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

7
8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the
9 operations of the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services
10 will become due and payable before the next fiscal year; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
13 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
15 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety; now, therefore,

18 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

19 **Additional allocation of Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund.**
20 Income to the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund of the
21 following sum is allocated to carry out the purpose of this Act.
