COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 88, L.D. 90, Bill, "An Act to Require the Department of Human Services to Investigate Zero Discharge Systems"

Amend the bill in the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in paragraph H, in the first line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "services" the following: 'after consultation with the Department of Environmental Protection.'

Further amend the bill in paragraph H, in the 3rd line (page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "April" and inserting in its place the underlined word 'July'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
