35	This bill provides for the establishment of a secure
37	treatment unit at the Maine Youth Center to house and treat youths who cannot be effectively housed or treated within the
39	existing housing units at the center. It targets a specific population of juvenile clients who pose a security risk and who
41	do not respond to existing services provided by the center.
