Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission may establish special prices on certain listed liquor items to be made available to the consumer at all state stores. These special prices must-not-be-lower than shall be the same as the price established for the same listed item at the 2 discount state liquor stores authorized under section 403.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The State Liquor Commission offers monthly special prices on designated brands. Each month, a different brand is featured and offered at a reduced rate at liquor stores statewide. discount liquor store at Kittery sells liquor at prices 23 competitive with those of neighboring New Hampshire stores. Consequently, these prices are lower than those at other Maine liquor stores. This bill requires the commission to set the price of the monthly special at the price of that item in the Kittery discount store.
