An Act to Provide an Income Tax Checkoff to Support the United States Olympic Team.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **36 MRSA §5286 is enacted to read:**

5 **§5286. United States Olympic Team voluntary checkoff**

7 Taxpayers who, when filing their returns, are entitled to a
9 refund under this Part, may designate that any part of that
11 refund be paid over to the United States Olympic Team. Taxpayers
13 who are not entitled to a refund under this Part may contribute
15 to the United States Olympic Team by including with their return
17 sufficient funds to make the contribution. Each individual
19 income tax form shall contain a designation in substantially the
21 following form:

23 "United States Olympic Team: () \$1, () \$5, () \$10
or () other \$."

21 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

23 This bill authorizes the creation of a voluntary state
income tax checkoff in support of the United States Olympic Team.
